SCHEDULE OF NOTES

1. This form may be lodged as an original only and must be printed, typed or completed in ink or biro. Alterations to information entered on the form should be crossed out (not erased or obliterated by painting over) and initialled by the parties. All signatures must be in ink or biro. A revocation by way of deed must bear the imprint of the Commissioner of Taxes (Stamp Duty).
2. Number of the power of attorney assigned by the Registrar.
3. Insert full name of the Donor. Address is not required.
4. Insert full name of the Donee. Address if not required.
5. Although a witness is not required under the *Powers of Attorney Act* it is preferable that the document be witnessed. However the document will not be rejected if there is no witness.

The Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Environment also uses the information supplied to prepare and sell or licence property sales reports to commercial organisations concerned with the development, sale or marketing of property.

Failure to provide the information in full or in part may prevent your application or transaction being completed.
